



Do you water your flowers regularly, but they die anyway? Your problem has been solved. Leona Wilkinson has published a book called *Gardening for Dummies*.

I interviewed Leona, Lennie to her friends and family, at the Royal Ballet Studio in London. She is currently working on her new role in *Swan Lake*. "A lot of people seemed rather surprised when my book came out," she says. 


